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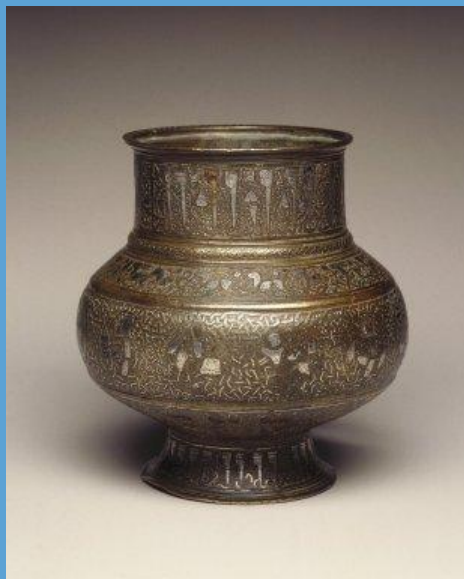
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THE MISSION OF THE DC ARABIC TEACHERS' COUNCIL IS TO:
